Route Optimisation Work on Apollo Drive

Auckland Transport is proposing the following improvements on Apollo Drive. We would like to give you the opportunity to comment.

Currently, parking in some spots on Apollo Drive presents a safety issue, with cars pulling out of parking spaces into busy traffic and impeding the line of sight for vehicles entering and exiting driveways. There is also an issue with vehicles waiting to turn into high use driveways, blocking the flow of traffic, which is unable to move around parked vehicles. The proposed installation of three NSAAT (no stopping at any time) restrictions on Apollo Drive will ease these issues.

The proposed changes are part of the on-going Regional Route Optimisation Project which coordinates traffic signals, clearways and parking restrictions so that traffic can travel smoothly. It is a process which ensures the most coordinated, efficient and safe operation of a road, and ultimately, leads to improvements in efficiency of the whole transport network. Long term, positive effects are felt throughout the community in terms of reduced vehicle fuel consumption and CO₂ emissions, increased road user safety and continuing contribution to economic development, accessibility and mobility.
