

Business North Harbour Leadership and Business Mentoring Programme

I am delighted to announce that following the success of the Women in Leadership Mentoring Programme in 2021, Business North Harbour (BNH) is ready to launch two **Leadership and Business Mentoring Programmes** which will run concurrently in 2022.

One programme will accommodate female mentees who prefer a female mentor, while the other will be a mixture of male and female mentors and mentees.

The programme has been developed in conjunction with Dr. Patricia Bossons, Leadership and Coaching Lead, Massey Executive Development and is a little different from the array of business skills mentoring opportunities which already exist, as it offers a unique opportunity for mentees to be mentored on leadership skills in addition to business topics, by successful business leaders from within the BNH business community.

The programme, **which for BNH members is completely free of charge**, aims to develop leaders and potential leaders in our businesses, thus mentorship training leadership topics **might** include:

Leadership v Management – developing followship Leadership Behaviours (authenticity, transparency, vulnerability, empathy, selfawareness etc) Difficult Conversations Succession Planning Letting Go Exit Strategies - How does the business run without you?

Mentors and mentees will be invited to attend a half-day training workshop with Dr. Patricia Bossons on Wednesday 16th February 2022, here at Business North Harbour which will be structured as follows:

9am – 12pm Mentor Training 12pm – 1pm Mentors and Mentees Shared Lunch 1pm – 3pm Mentee Training

(**Please note:** Prior to attendance mentors and mentees will need to complete some pre-workshop preparation which will only take around 30 minutes)

Following the training workshop, it is expected that the mentor/mentee sessions will commence in early March 2022. It is envisaged that each mentor would work 1:1 with each mentee, meeting approximately every 4 to 6 weeks, with each mentee being mentored for around 10 months.

During the programme we will invite mentors and mentees back to BNH for a couple of hours to give feedback and share experiences after 3 months and 7 months.
