

Auckland Transport Bollards Update



With a recent increase in RAM raiding incidents, **Auckland Transport** wishes to advise that it is working on simplifying the process for bollard installation for small business owners. AT generally does not install bollards outside businesses for building protection purposes, due to the high costs of ongoing maintenance at the expense of the public. However, where a site has experienced ram-raiding or repeated vehicle accidents, AT will consider the installation of bollards near the front of their building at the landowner's expense. Accredited Employer Work Visa Webinar



Immigration New Zealand invites members to an upcoming webinar about the last two steps of the new **Accredited Employer Work Visa (AEWV)**, the job check and the visa application. The three steps to hiring a migrant on an AEWV involve employer accreditation, the job check, and the visa application. Employers can apply for accreditation from the 23rd May and for a job check from 20th June. The work visa opens to applications on the 4th July.

Employers accredited with Immigration New Zealand will be able to hire migrant workers on a new visa where no New Zealanders are available to do a job, and where a genuine skill or labour shortage exists. Register for this webinar [here](#) which will take place at 11.00am on Wednesday 18th May.






