

## New carbon emissions calculator for business



## Northern Corridor Improvement



### Northern Corridor Improvements

The 5km Northern Busway extension from Constellation Station to Albany Station is now open, providing traffic-free travel from the Auckland Harbour Bridge all the way to Albany.

All large construction projects have been affected by the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic with the impact extending beyond the project team, with subcontractors and workers employed in the extended supply chain also being impacted. The project is due for completion in mid-2023.


