



Half-Price Fares Extended Until January 2023

Between 1st April and 31st January 2023, a 50% discount will apply to **AT** bus, train and ferry fares. For staff that commute, 50%* off their travel costs can make a huge difference to their finances, so make sure you spread the word among your workplace.

Staff can cap their travel costs at \$107.50 per month with a bus and train monthly pass. It can keep longer journeys like Papakura to Britomart to just \$6.12 per day for a return journey, or Albany to Britomart for \$2.43 each way. Learn more

East Coast Bays Wastewater Link




Watercare are updating the waste water network. The works starts this month and they aim to finish by April 2024.

They are building a new larger 1.75 km wastewater pipeline from Windsor Park along Centorian Drive and Apollo Drive to Rosedale Wastewater Treatment Plant. This new pipeline together with the Sidmouth Pump Station upgrade (currently in construction) will contribute to increasing the wastewater transmission capacity in the East Coast Bays catchment. It will also cater for growth and help eliminate overflows.

Lanes Set To Change Southbound On The Northern Motorway






