New information about work in your neighbourhood

On behalf of everyone at Auckland Transport, we hope this letter finds you and your whānau well.

Last month, we sent you a letter about our plans to construct a new footpath connection along Bush Road. Unfortunately, there was a mistake on the drawing we sent with the letter. The drawing showed broken yellow lines (no stopping at all times) alongside the new footpath. That detail was incorrect as cars will still be able to park along this section of the road.

An updated drawing has been sent with this letter.

Project description

Upper Harbour Local Board and Auckland Transport are planning to:

- Construct a footpath on the eastern side of Bush Road. The footpath will be 3m wide and approximately 280m long. It will connect the existing footpath outside the National Hockey Centre to the footpath on Rosedale Road.

We're doing this work to make it easier and safer to walk around your area. Currently, the eastern side of Bush Road does not have a safe path for approximately 280m. This project will provide a safe and continuous footpath for people to use to access the National Hockey Centre.

What happens next

We expect construction will begin in **February 2023**. We may need to delay the work or make other plans if the weather is poor or the contractor changes. If this happens, we will contact you again.

Our contractors will send notices to residents or businesses affected by the work 48 hours before it starts.
