## **Corinthian Drive Proposed Bus Stop Removals**

Business North Harbour (BNH) representing the North Harbour Business Improvement District welcomes the opportunity to provide member feedback on Auckland Transport (AT) proposal for the removal of all three bus stops on Corinthian Drive, Albany.

BNH is a significant commercial and industrial Business Improvement District (BID), representing over 4,500 commercial property owners and businesses within the North Harbour area. Collectively they employ over 35,000 Auckland residents and ratepayers.

The BNH area is located within the Upper Harbour Local Board area, which is expected to be the fastest growing area in the country over the next ten years, in both absolute and percentage population terms¹ which brings both challenges and opportunities to the North Harbour business district. BNH represents and works with a wide range of businesses comprising of a mix of sole traders, Small Medium Enterprises (SME), through to multinational organisations. Representing sectors such as ICT, business services, specialist manufacturing, light and medium warehousing, logistics, retail, and hospitality. In addition, the area has key educational institutions within or on its boundary, including Massey University Albany and AUT Millennium, along with a variety of primary and secondary schools including Rangitoto College, the largest secondary school in New Zealand. All are located within an industrial estate which is on average less than 25 years old.

Of critical importance to the Association and our members is enabling members, employees, and customers to access the most effective options to commute to and through the business precinct, either via the efficiency and effectiveness of the strategic network roading (and the connections to motorways) and/or via well-serviced public transport.

Due to the short time frame, we specifically asked members only located on Corinthian Drive for feedback.

We had a total of twenty respondents. With one 'For', and nineteen 'Against'. Please find Appendix 1 for their individual feedback.\* Please note this submission will be forwarded to the Public Transport Planning Team at Auckland Transport.

Although only a small sample responded, there was an overwhelming majority of 95% that oppose the planned removal, with a commanding request to reinstate the bus route.

BNH have taken into consideration Auckland Councils target of halving emissions by 2030, which directly impacts Auckland Transport's public transport targets.
BNH also believes that there must be an increase in public transport options to encourage the NZ public to change, rather than penalising them.

Therefore, Business North Harbour opposes the planned removal of the bus stops.
