

On 04 July 2022, Immigration New Zealand rolled out an entirely new Work Visa process for employers looking to secure new skills from offshore. As part of that process, employers were required to play a much bigger role in the Visa system with more responsibility and compliance being added to the equation.

Following a letter written to Government Ministers and local MPs in September regarding the need for members to gain access to more people more quickly to help with the labour shortage, Vanushi




Recycling will reduce your business waste and your impact on the environment. r3pack provides recycling to its customers for 2 new streams:

- Soft Plastics such as most clean and dry food packaging, courier bags, and other soft plastics marked with LDPE or Recycle Logo 4.
- Courier Label backing paper (known as glassine paper) can't be recycled with other paper or cardboard, however can be recycled into tissue paper.

Corinthian Drive Update



In September, AT notified BNH of the planned removal of the bus stops on Corinthian Drive. Although there are no current bus routes that travel the roughly 1.2km road, AT have told BNH that it is in its long-term plan to reintroduce the service.

With the street parking exceeding capacity we asked our members what they want. We had over 90% saying they want the bus stops to remain and asking for the service to be reintroduced.

After reviewing our submission AT have agreed to keep the bus stops however, they have said that at this stage there is no budget for reintroducing the service.

Drive interchange, the far-left lane of the SH1 Upper Harbour Highway northbound offramp has

the light phasing across interchanges, two onramps and two offramps. It's a complex location which requires 47 different light signal aspects to ensure everyone can get around and help manage congestion during peak times. Each of the 47 light signal aspects all need to 'talk to each other' to ensure optimised sequencing and efficiency of the interchange for all modes of transport – whether on foot, by bike or whilst driving a vehicle.
