Arrenway Reserve Now Open



Creating welcoming places and spaces is important so that whānau and friends can enjoy their local neighbourhood together.

As part of the project, work has been undertaken to upgrade Arrenway Reserve to include bike parking, bench seating and lighting along with grassed areas and native planting. The main change is that the reserve will also have a direct connection to the shared path which is due to open next year and will run alongside SH1 between Oteha Valley Road and Constellation Station. The shared path will provide choice for how people get around their local community or commute to places of work, so connections at key locations – such as the reserve, which is within the Rosedale industrial area – are important.

Before the reserve opened, our mana whenua partners led a dawn karakia along with attendance from the project team and the Upper Harbour Local Board.
