

Retail Crime Prevention Programme - Update June 2023




Stay informed about the latest efforts of the Police in combatting retail crime.

The Police are committed to minimising the impact of retail crime on business owners and staff, and are actively collaborating with industry partners to address the issue. They respond to incidents at both district and national levels, conducting thorough investigations to identify culprits and prevent future offences. The Police offer various forms of support, including the National Retail Investigation Support Unit, dedicated operations targeting retail crime, and the Retail Crime Prevention Programme, which provides assistance to retailers affected by aggravated robberies or ram raids.

Additionally, the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment offers the Fog Cannon Subsidy Scheme to aid small retailers, even if they haven't been victims of such crimes.




Open Spaces To Support Your Health And Wellbeing

Matariki - The Māori New Year

Matariki, also known as the Māori New Year, is a significant event that holds cultural and spiritual importance for the Māori people. It occurs when the Pleiades star cluster, also known as the Seven Sisters, rises above the horizon in the winter months.

During Matariki, communities come together to honour the past, celebrate the present and prepare for the future. It is a time for reflection, remembrance, and gratitude. People gathered with their families and loved ones to acknowledge those who have passed away, share meals, perform traditional rituals and dances, and participate in various cultural activities.

Matariki symbolizes new beginnings, the cycle of life and the connection between people and the land. It is seen as a time of renewal and rejuvenation, a moment to set goals and aspirations for the coming year, and a chance to strengthen family and community bonds.

Overall, Matariki holds great significance in Māori culture, serving as a time of celebration, reflection, and unity within the community.
