A customer or one of your staff needs urgent medical assistance. You are the first and possibly the only person there to respond. You've rung 111, and the St John Ambulance is on its way. What you do in the next 4-12 minutes before the St John Ambulance arrives could save that person's life.

St John has designed a two-hour workshop to up-skill staff. Attendees will be shown how to deal with the five most common situations they are likely to encounter in their workplace environment which could be a cardiac arrest, a falling injury, or a person cut and badly bleeding. The aim of this workshop is to up-skill staff to compliment, or assist, your fully trained first aiders.

Roadworks On Apollo Drive And Piermark Drive

Apollo Drive East Coast Bays Link Sewer – August till the end of October.

We would like to inform you that Watercare will be commencing the next stage of work for the East Coast Bays Link Sewer project. The construction will take place on Apollo Drive from the beginning of August until the end of October, Monday to Friday, between 9.00 am and 8.00 pm. During this construction period, Apollo Drive will continue to accommodate two-way traffic; however, please note that only one lane will be open for vehicles. To manage traffic flow effectively and ensure safety, stop-go traffic management will be in place.

The construction area will be limited to the section between 34 Apollo Drive and just before the intersection with Constellation Drive.

We strongly advise all motorists to plan their journeys accordingly, and if possible, use alternative routes or public transportation to avoid potential delays.

Piermark Drive Vector Project Alignment - August till the end of October

Scot Thrust is about to start this project on behalf of Vector for a new 33kVa undergrounding project to upgrade the old existing cables that are coming to the end of their lifespan.

The work will start off on the corner of Piermark Drive and Bush Road and then head towards William Pickering Drive then returning to complete Bush Road side as the final stage.

All the work will be completed in the daytime apart from the Bush Road crossing which will be done at night. Scot Thrust is looking at doing their work in 200m-300m sections to enable areas to be kept open for parking.

Crowded Places Strategy



Move quickly and quietly away from danger, but only if it is safe to do so.

Stay out of sight and silence your mobile phone.



-The Crowded Places Strategy is an **all of Government strategy** to help enable owners and operators of crowded places protect the lives of people working in and visiting crowded places. -Owners and operators of crowded places must take the first steps and use the documentation online.

-The self-assessment form is step one and must be completed by the owner/operator. -The layered security approach of Deter, Detect, Delay, Respond should be applied when considering how best to make a location safe.

- An Escape. Hide. Tell plan should be established and be specific for each location. All staff/employees/place of worship leaders etc need to be aware of the plan and have discussed/walked through the plan.

-The aim of any discussion about the strategy is to Inform people, not inflame so offer reassurance about how rare these events are before talking about it.
