Olympic Triumph In Paris

Business North Harbour Celebrates NZ's Historic



Olympic Games. The New Zealand team celebrated its most successful Olympic Games, winning 20 medals, including 10 Gold, 7 Silver, and 3 Bronze. This achievement surpasses their previous best of eight Gold medals at the 1984 Los Angeles Olympics and equals the total medal count of 20 at Tokyo 2020, placing New Zealand 11th on the medal table. Medals came from nine sports.
