ExportNZ Food & Beverage Group: MPI Consultation - Options For Export Exemptions For Labelling And **Composition**



MPI is currently <u>consulting on options</u> for export exemptions from New Zealand composition and/or labelling requirements under the Food Act 2014.

Currently, all food for sale in NZ must comply with NZ food standards and also the NZ/Australia labelling and composition requirements. Where an importing country's labelling requirements differ from NZ, the exporter is required to submit an application to MPI to have the exported product exempt from NZ requirements. A process, ExportNZ understands can be onerous.

MPI is consulting on possible changes and has proposed the following options, including maintaining the status quo: read more here


