Government Agrees To Toll Three New Highways Being Built In The North Island



to north of Levin, the Takitimu North Link connecting Tauranga to Te Puna and Penlink in Auckland. Penlink will be a new 7km highway between Whangaparāoa Road and State Highway 1 that will create a more resilient network and get people where they need to go faster. These will be the first new tolled roads in years, doubling the existing number of tolled highways.


