Auckland Regional Fuel Tax To End On June 30th





The Auckland Regional Fuel Tax, introduced to fund transport projects, is set to be cut at the end of June.

Transport Minister Simeon Brown has confirmed that, "as of September 2023, around \$780 million in Regional Fuel Tax revenue had been raised, with approximately \$341 million remaining unspent (the equivalent of more than two years' worth of revenue)". This move comes in response to public concern over rising living costs and aims to provide financial relief to Aucklanders. The 11.5 cents per litre tax has significantly contributed to Auckland's transport infrastructure budget, but its removal is expected to ease the financial burden on residents.


