

Earlier this year Watercare and our contractors undertook CCTV investigations within the East Coast Bays to assess the condition of the existing wastewater network. These investigations have identified a short section of pipeline that will require remedial work – PLEASE SEE MAP ABOVE

The problematic pipelines will be relined using trenchless technology via several manholes located within public reserves, roadways, and private property.

HOW WILL THIS STAGE OF THE PROJECT AFFECT YOU?


- This stage of the project is scheduled to take place between **mid November 2024 late** December 2024. • Working hours will be 7am – 6pm Monday to Friday and 7am – 6pm on Saturday.
- Temporary traffic management plans will be in place on several streets in the area. We ask
- that you please follow the direction of traffic management staff and traffic signage to ensure everyone is kept safe. • Given the nature of these works the team may be required to work simultaneously across
- multiple areas. You may notice the team accessing/leaving sites several times during the specified work period. • Should we need to access your property you will be notified in advance.
- Controls such as fencing, and signage will be in place for the safety of the public and our
- workers. • These works will generate some noise; however, noise levels will be kept to a minimum and
- in accordance with the levels approved by Auckland Council. • Access to properties will be maintained throughout the project; however, if there is a need for access to be restricted you will be notified in advance.
- Works will not affect your wastewater services however there may be a temporary localised odour in an around the worksites.
