# Is Pessimism Turning To Optimism?

Recent cuts in the Official Cash Rate (OCR) which saw banks reduce their interest rates and the decrease in the Consumer Price Index (CPI), which is currently sitting at 2.2 per cent, the first time that the figure has fallen within the Reserve Bank of New Zealand's (RBNZ) target of between 1 – 3 per cent since March 2021, are definitely cause for optimism. Some economists are predicting that we should expect a further reduction in the OCR in November, which would be another positive sign that financial pressures are easing. We're not out of the woods yet, however the signs are encouraging and with interest rates and inflation predicted to ease further, I would like to think that a more positive future for members is hopefully not too far away.






