
Our Speakers:






## Increases To Parking Infringement And Towage Fees From 1st October



by less than 30 minutes will rise from \$12 to \$20, while fines for parking on footpaths or blocking driveways will increase from \$40 to \$70. These changes are mandated by the Government as part of a crackdown on misuse of disabled parking, which will see fines for such violations soar from \$150 to \$750. The new fees also reflect inflation adjustments to help local councils manage parking more effectively.
