We're excited to announce that applications are now open for the **Upper Harbour Ethnic Peoples Plan (UHEPP) Community Action Funding 2025–2030!**

This funding supports grassroots projects that strengthen ethnic communities in the Upper Harbour Local Board area and align with the objectives of the UHEPP.

Key Details:

- Two funding streams:
 - *Stream 1:* Larger projects (\$2,500–\$5,000) – Apply by 1st February 2026
 - *Stream 2:* Smaller projects (\$500–\$1,000) – Apply by 31st March 2026
- Projects must be delivered by 30th June 2026
- Priority given to applicants who have never applied for funding and new community-led ideas
