Costs Are Still On The Rise

Whilst there is a generally positive vibe around at the moment regarding an improvement in the economy, pressure continues to be placed upon business and household budgets according to the latest figures from Stats NZ.

Food prices increased by 4% overall in the year to December 2025, with electricity and gas prices increasing by 12.2% and 17.5% respectively in the same period. In addition to these increases, petrol prices were up 1.4% and diesel 4% annually, all of which leaves many people with little or no disposable income to put back into the local economy, a problem compounded by the job insecurity that a number of people remain wary of due to the increase in unemployment over recent times.

Despite these ongoing challenges, I trust that BNH members are managing to navigate their way through these difficult economic times and hope that the positive vibe turns into tangible economic growth for members in the not-too-distant future.

Auckland Transport Annual Parking Price Adjustment



- AT's parking prices across Tāmaki Makaurau will be adjusted on 1st February 2026.
- On-street parking charges will increase by 50c per hour across most of Auckland.
- Parnell will remain unchanged, including Nicholls Lane and The Strand, where prices will also stay the same.

As Auckland grows, the cost of maintaining and servicing parking goes up too. We review prices every year to keep things fair and make sure these costs don't fall entirely on ratepayers. Prices also reflect demand and market trends.
