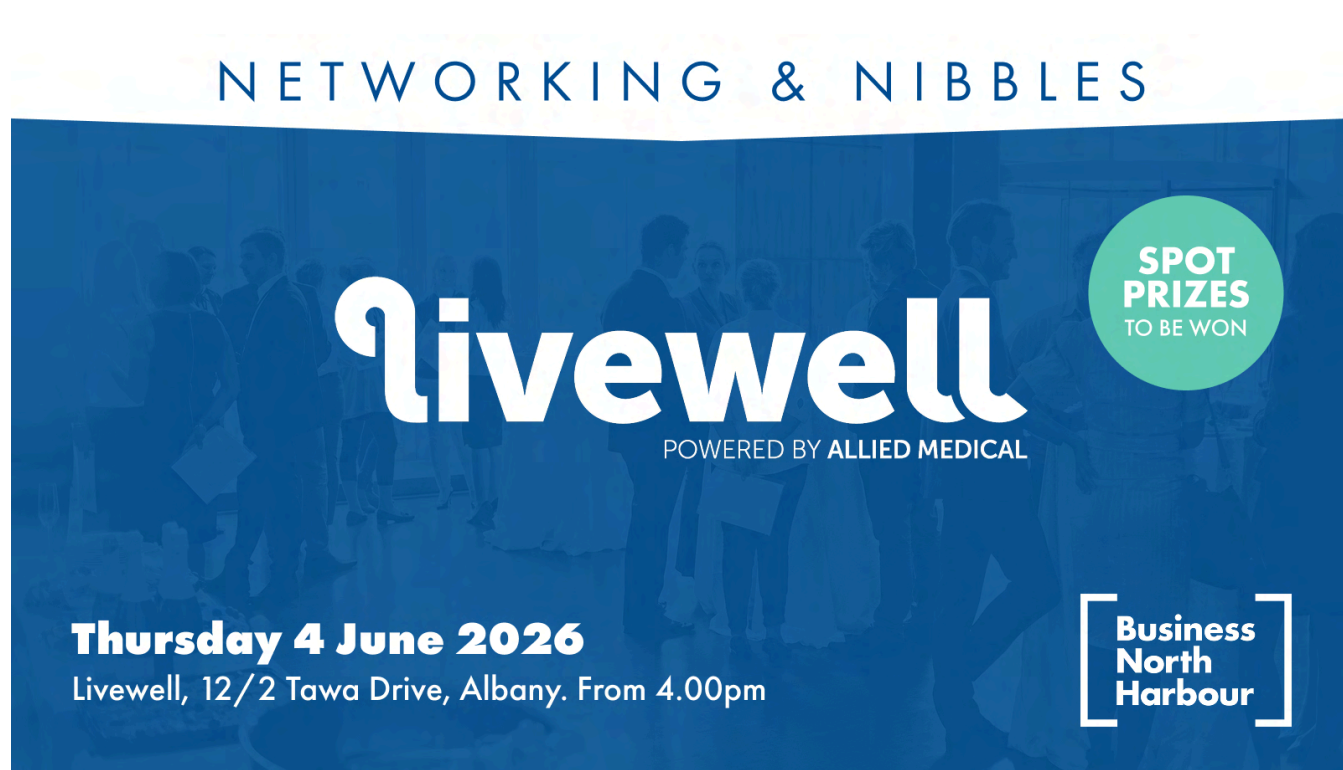

Major NZ Tax Changes Ahead: Is Your Business Ready?



Recent updates from Inland Revenue highlight several important tax changes that could impact businesses this year. From 1 April 2026, KiwiSaver contribution rates have increased to 3.5% for both employers and employees, including eligibility for younger workers aged 16–17. Businesses should ensure payroll systems are updated and be prepared to manage temporary rate reduction requests where applicable.

There are also new rules around fringe benefit tax (FBT), giving businesses more flexibility in how certain benefits — such as vehicles, gift cards, and reimbursements — are treated. Reviewing how these are currently handled could help ensure compliance while potentially improving tax efficiency.

Another key change is the introduction of “Investment Boost,” a tax incentive that allows businesses to claim a 20% deduction on new business assets like equipment, machinery and work vehicles. This provides a valuable opportunity to reduce your tax bill while investing in growth.

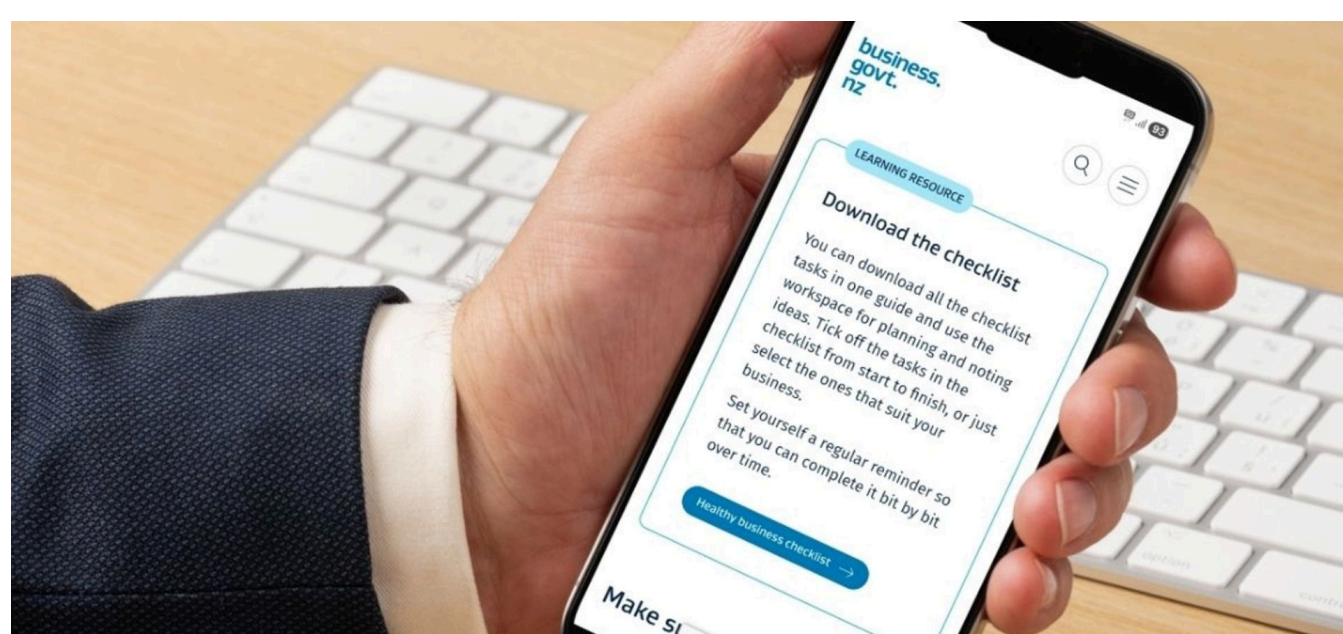

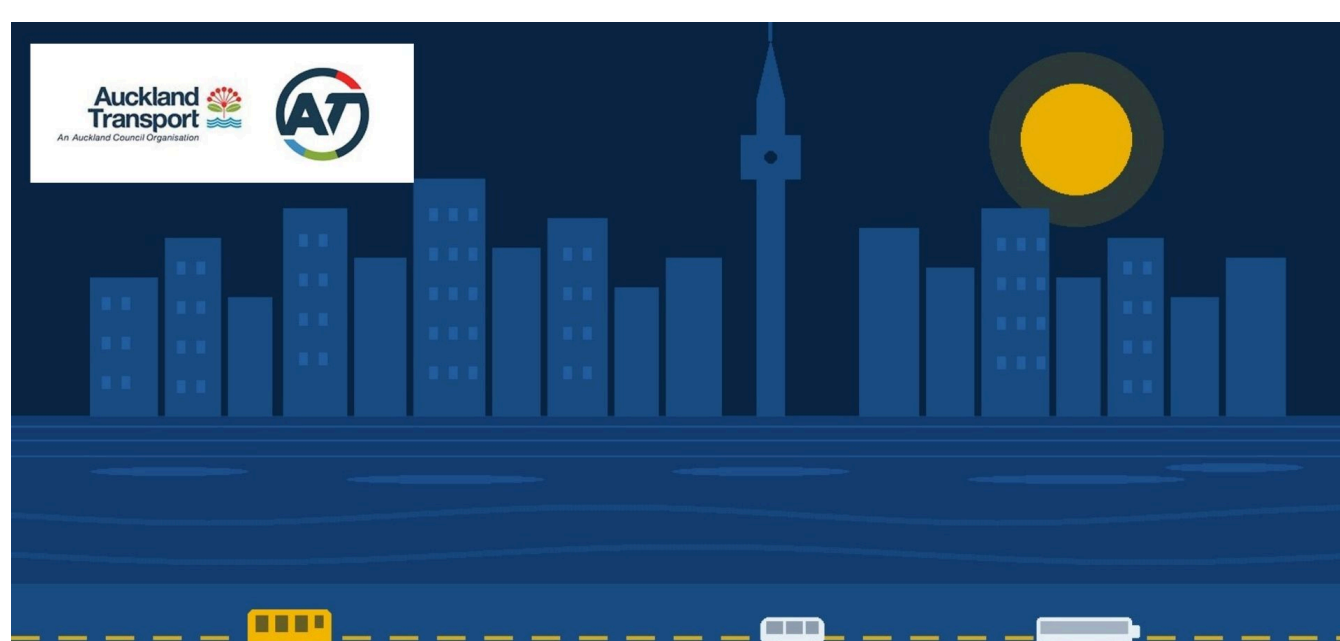

Transport Governance Reform In Auckland



New legislation has been passed that changes how transport is planned, governed and delivered in Auckland. The Local Government (Auckland Council) (Transport Governance) Amendment Act 2026 introduces three key changes:

- A new Auckland Regional Transport Committee (ARTC) will lead long-term transport planning, including a 30-year Transport Plan and the Regional Land Transport Plan.
- A statutory CCO will continue to deliver public transport services.
- Auckland Council will take on all other transport functions, including Road Controlling Authority responsibilities, shifting decision-making from Auckland Transport to the Governing Body and local boards.

These changes must be implemented within six months. Work is already underway, including staff consultation, new governance arrangements, and transition planning across policies, systems and processes. Transport Change Director Steve Mutton is overseeing the transition for both council and Auckland Transport.
